Initiatives that can be completed without significant funding:

- I. Increase effective communication across campus

 - Utilization of resources to promote career centers, career fairs, and post-graduate preparation/counseling across campus divisions
- III. Legal Consultation Services for students
 - Accessible services set up for all students on campus
- IV. Engagement of entire state
 - Create initiatives and programs to engage potential students across demographics as they progress through secondary education

Initiatives that are in need of significant funding:

- I. Expansion of studies and academic disciplines
 - Implementation of interdisciplinary studies and majors
 - Expansion of graduate disciplines offered
- II. Improvement of student facilities
 - To create/remodel facilities that are aesthetically pleasing, innovative, and conducive to the various learning styles of students
 - Student Success Center
- III. Increase in the faculty/staff to student ratio
 - Work to decrease the gap between the number of students on campus and the faculty and staff, as has been propagated by the increase in student population
