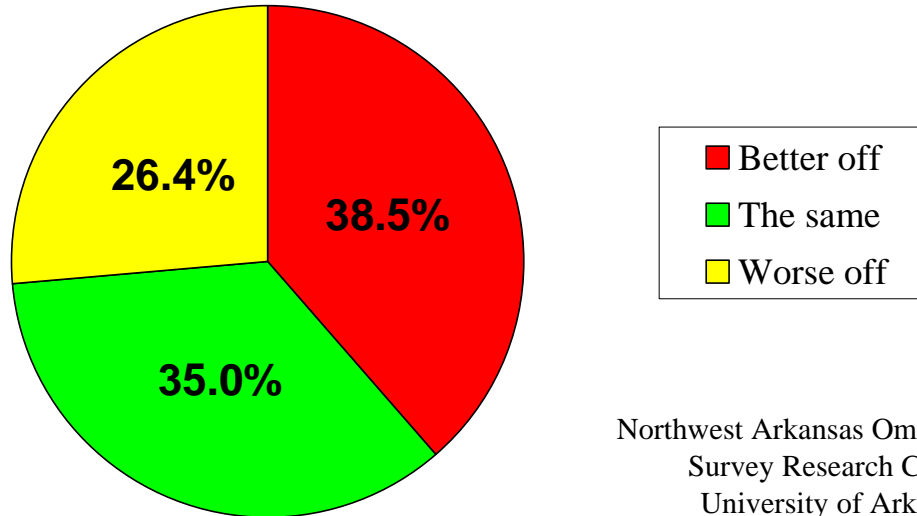
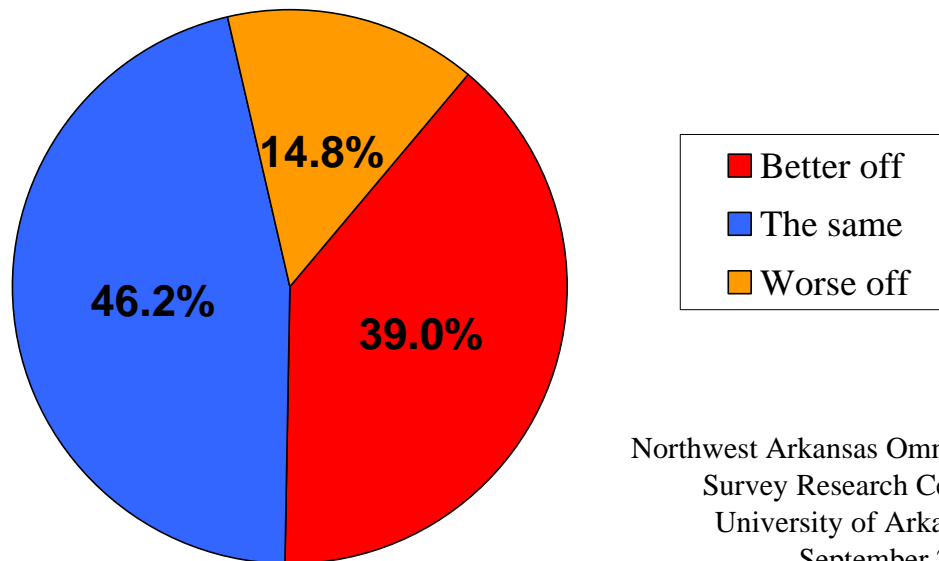


Would you say that you (and your family living there) are better off or worse off financially than you were a year ago?



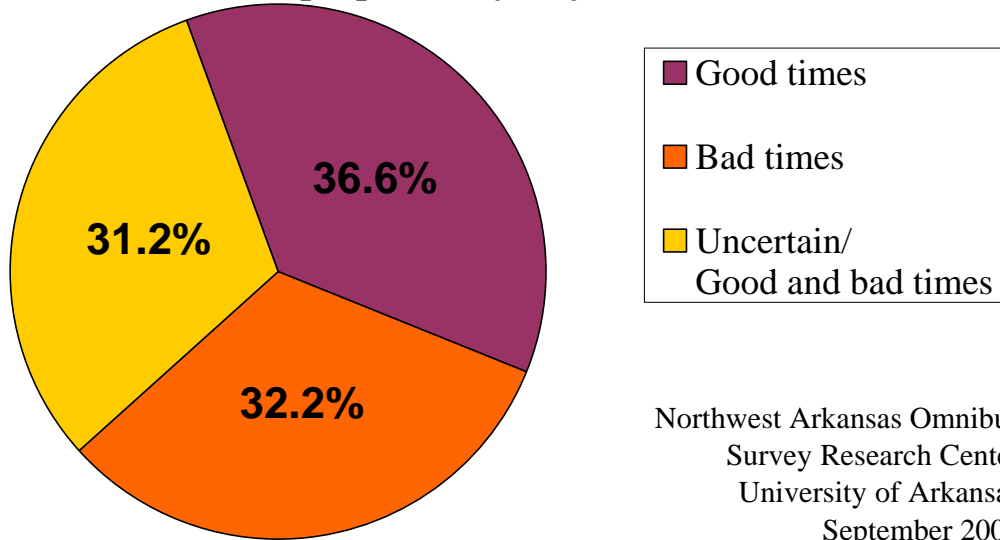

Do you think that a year from now you (and your family living there) will be better off financially, worse off, or about the same as now?



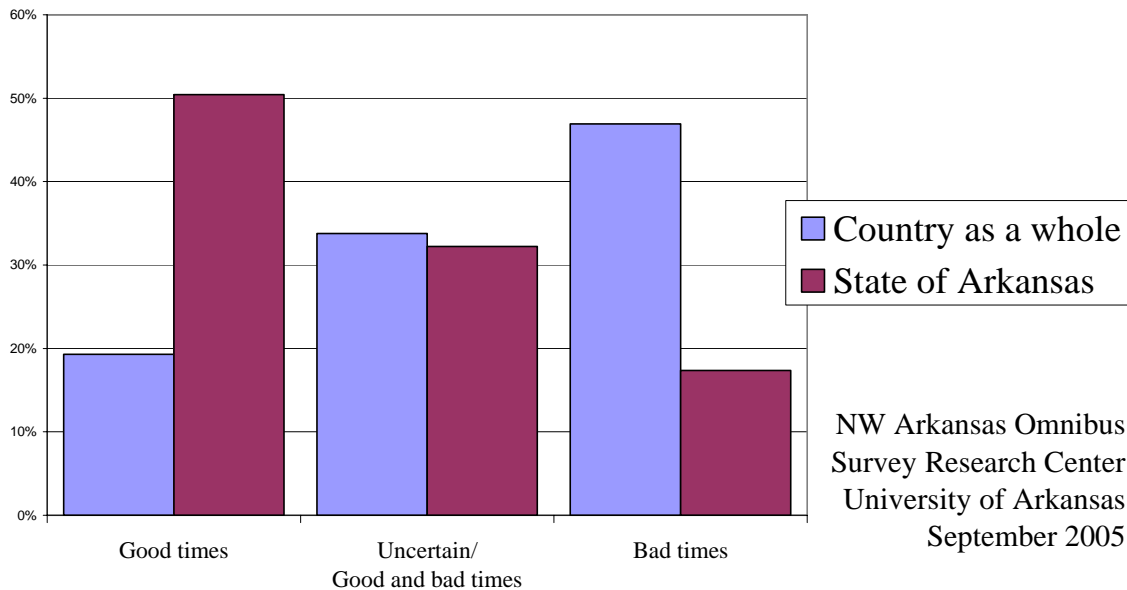

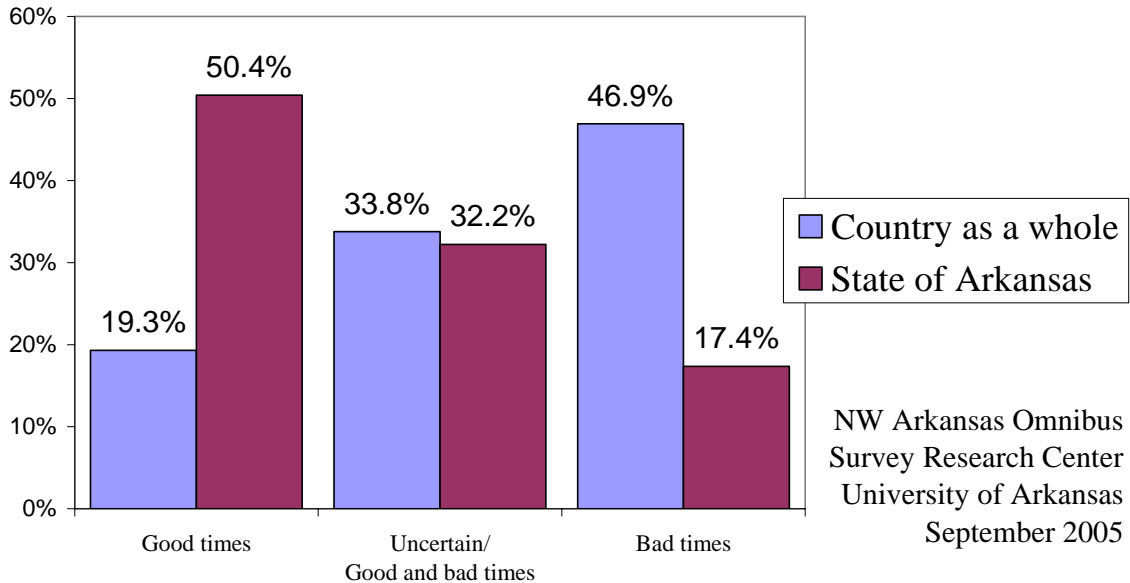

Do you think that during the next 12 months we'll have good times financially, bad times or what?

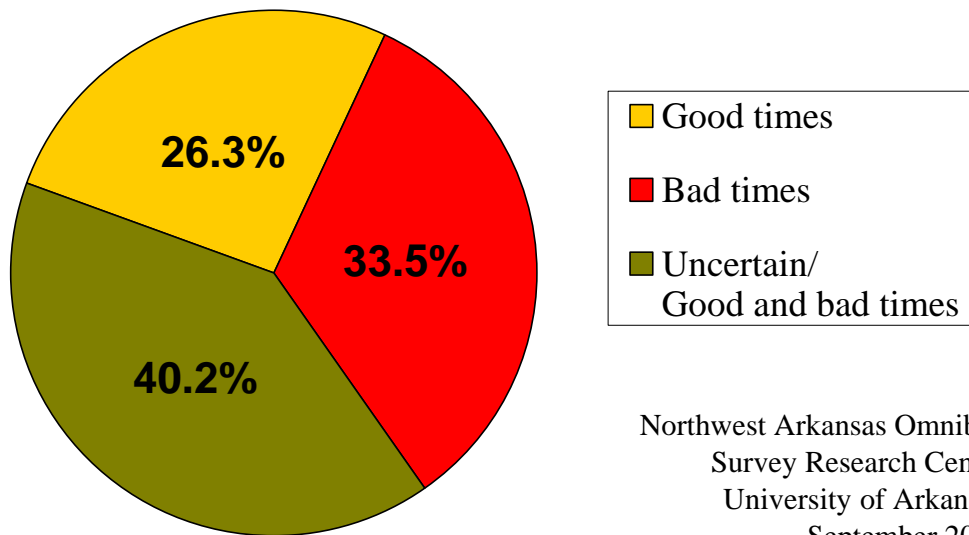

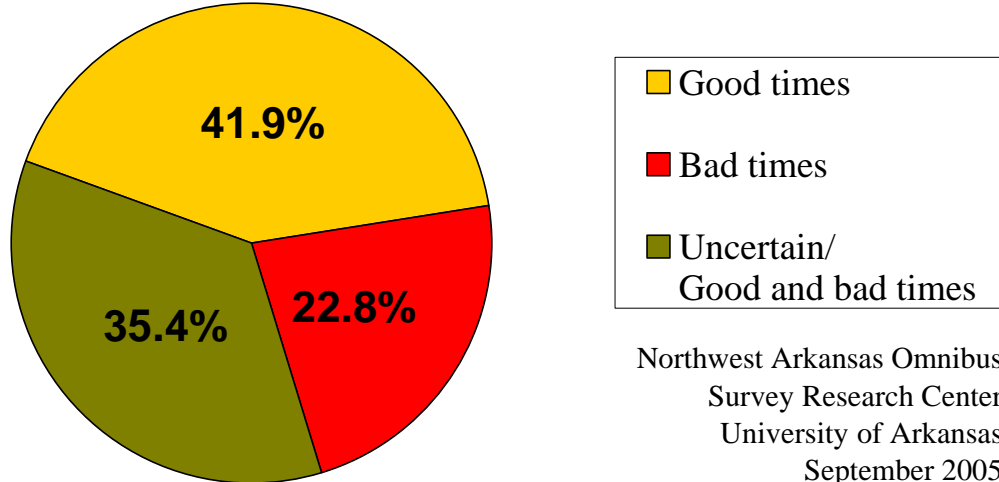
Do you think that during the next 12 months we'll have good times financially, bad times or what?



Which would you say is more likely - that in the country as a whole we'll have continuous good times during the next 5 years or so, that we'll have periods of widespread unemployment or depression or what?

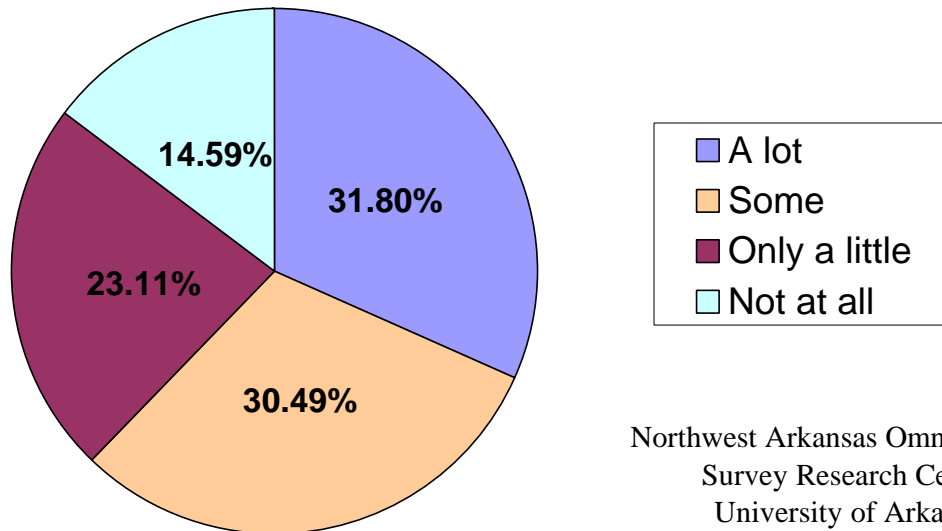

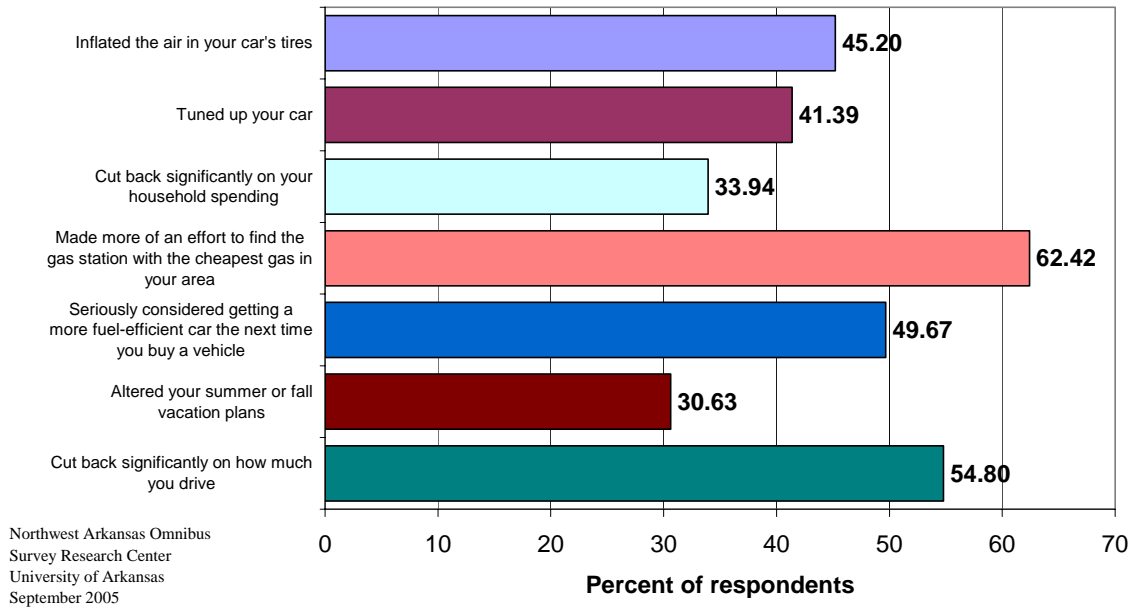
